The news has spread like wildfire and we couldn't be happier! YES! We have taken ownership of Mystic Mountain Adventure Golf & Driving Range, located on M-25 in Worth Township, just a mile and a half south of Lexington and we are proudly operating under the new name of

"PUTT'IN 4 PAWS"

After months of research, planning, and meetings with township officials, we were officially and warmly welcomed into the neighborhood. In what seemed like an instant, we were learning to shag golf balls, tend greens and scoop ice cream. The support and enthusiasm of the

community continues to energize and motivate us.

People should not think we are awash with cash. Most of the money for the project has come from the wills of a few animal lovers who bequeathed it to us. We strive to take in as many animals as possible but we are limited by the size of our current facility. A new, larger shelter will allow us to take in and re-home so many more healthy, adoptable animals who might otherwise end up in a municipal facility where their fate is unknown.

We remain patient and hopeful that the new shelter will become a reality by the Fall of 2016, and until then we reach out to anyone who will listen, to help raise the additional funding needed to make our dream a reality.

In addition to sheltering and re-homing so many more dogs and cats, we intend to provide much needed, **affordable veterinary care** in our fully equipped animal clinic.

Consider an adoption with individual consultants and "meet & greet" areas for you and your family to spend time with your new potential family member. This larger facility will also include a dog park, short term day care, dog training, grooming, a walking path around the perimeter of the 10 acre property, and a resale shop exclusively for pet supplies. Our feline friends will enjoy the comforts of temperature controlled indoor accommodations, and secure, screened-in "Catios" with plenty of toys and exercise equipment.
